

Pickleball Court Rules

- Courts are available on a first come, first served basis for both doubles and singles play (City permits receive priority, but are only provided on limited occasions).
- If courts are full and players are waiting, court time is limited to 20 minutes. Players can rotate back onto courts as many times as they desire.
- When courts are full, waiting players may place paddles next to the net of a game in play. When the game is over, players will relinquish the court to those waiting, as follows:
 - 4 paddles down: all players leave court to those waiting.
 - 2 paddles down: the winning team may stay on, or the waiting players may choose to play singles.
- Double stacking of paddles (playing a game while having a second paddle waiting on another court) is not allowed.
- An individual may not hold a court when players are waiting.
- Court shoes only, no cleats allowed.
- No wheeled vehicles allowed inside fence.
- Recreation department programs have priority use.
- No private lessons for compensation permitted.
